Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit

81% – Percent of patients admitted to Memorial’s Rehabilitation Unit who were discharged home, which is 5 percentage points **higher** than our regional compare group.

10 – The average number of days a patient admitted to Memorial’s Rehabilitation Unit stays on our unit before discharge, which, on average, is 2 days less than our national compare group.
