Why: The ambulance has been used by the Neonatal / Pediatric Emergency Transport Team at Memorial Children's Hospital for 16 years, serving thousands of critically ill and injured children in our community. It will now be used to help those responding to mass-casualty and other incidents requiring the activation of first-responders throughout our community.

As the region's only Level II Trauma Center, Memorial provides integrated care to injured patients from pre-hospital care (EMS, police, fire, air medial transportation), to in-patient care and rehabilitation services. This is another way Memorial is helping our partners in the community provide the best and most timely care to patients in the field.
