***Memorial Children's Hospital to Host 25th Annual
Newborn Intensive Care Unit Family Reunion***

Sept. 15, 2010 - Memorial Children's Hospital will host its 25th annual Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Family Reunion on Sunday, Sept. 19 from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. at Memorial's HealthWorks! Kids' Museum, located at 111 W. Jefferson Blvd. in downtown South Bend.

Children and families who have been cared for at Memorial's NICU are welcome to celebrate the lives of those children who have been a part of the Memorial NICU family.

The celebration includes refreshments and activities at HealthWorks!, an opportunity to visit with physicians and nurses who provide care for infants in the NICU, and special appearances by **Ronald McDonald and Jetta and the Jellybeans**.
