***Dallas Cowboy Star Quarterback Tony Romo to Visit  
Memorial Children's Hospital***

Cowboys quarterback Tony Romo will visit Memorial Children's Hospital Wednesday, April 28 at 2:30 p.m. His visit will include a trip to Memorial's pediatric and pediatric intensive care units, as well as patients in the Pediatric Hematology/Oncology program.

Romo has one of the most motivating success stories in recent NFL history, after ascending from the ranks of undrafted free agent – and three-year back-up quarterback – to a record setting, two-time Pro Bowl selection for the Dallas Cowboys.

“The Hall of Fame is honored to be able to partner with KeyBank to bring some of the most inspiring names in football to the community,” said Hall of Fame Executive Director **Lisa Klunder**. “The Hall of Fame values our strong relationship with Memorial Hospital and are fortunate that we are able to team up to make this visit possible.”

This visit coincides with his speaking engagement at the 2010 KeyBank Gridiron Legends Luncheon Series presented by the College Football Hall of Fame.
