

A University of Notre Dame student was taken to Memorial Hospital of South Bend after sustaining injuries from a fall on Wednesday (Oct. 27).

The student was filming Notre Dame football practice from a hydraulic scissor lift when the incident occurred. The student was transported to Memorial Hospital's Level II Trauma Center where the Trauma Team provided medical care. The student died shortly after arriving at Memorial.

"We are deeply saddened by this tragic loss," said Rev. John I. Jenkins, C.S.C., Notre Dame's president. "Our hearts go out to the student's family and friends and our prayers and profound sympathies are with them during this incredibly difficult time. The loss of someone so young is a terrible shock and a great sadness. Our entire community shares in the family's grief."
